Upon submitting this information your account will be created and you will be logged into the Bridges Educator site home page.

Next, set your grade level preference by clicking on the "My Settings" link in the top menu bar. On the settings page, scroll down to select the grade level(s) you wish to view and then click the Save button at the bottom of the page. (You can change your selections at any time).

When your account is created you automatically will be sent a welcome message containing site information and links for future reference.
