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AISES COLUMBIA RIVER PROFESSIONAL CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM For Fall 2022 – Spring 2023

(The deadline for all application materials is **June 1, 2022.**)

(Notification of Awards will be sent out on **July 1, 2022.**)

(Awards will be made in lump sum on **August 1, 2022.**)

Administered by the Columbia River Professional Chapter, this scholarship is made available to American Indian/Alaskan Native college students who reside in the states of Washington, Oregon or Idaho. This award is for one-year dependent upon academic standing.

CRITERIA Applicants must meet all of the following criteria. Late/incomplete applications will not receive consideration.

1. Must be college undergraduate or graduate student.
2. Must have a 2.5 or higher cumulative grade point average (GPA).
3. Must be a resident of or attending a college or university in: ___ Washington ___ Oregon ___ Idaho
4. Must be majoring in one of the following or related STEM areas of study:
Medicine Engineering Education (preferably in STEM related areas)
Mathematics Natural or Physical Science Health Sciences
5. Must be a member of an American Indian tribe or otherwise considered to be an American Indian by the tribe with which affiliation is claimed; or is at least 1/4 American Indian blood; or is at least 1/4 Alaskan Native; or considered to be an Alaskan Native by an Alaskan Native group to which affiliation is claimed.
6. Upon acceptance, students are encouraged to become an AISES member (www.aises.org/membership).

AWARDS UP TO \$2500

Notification of award is made July 1st and a single disbursement of award will be made at the beginning of fall semester.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

An official college transcript is required. Faxed photocopies and computer printouts by applicant will not be accepted in lieu of official documents.

PERSONAL ESSAY

On a separate sheet(s), the applicant must provide a 500-word essay. The essay must include reasons why a particular field of study was chosen, a description of the applicant's career aspirations, an evaluation of past scholastic performance and any obstacles faced as a student, and applicant's involvement and commitment to tribal community life. The essay must be attached to this application, typed using a font of 12 points, and double-spaced. The applicant's name and date must appear at the top of the sheet.

TRIBAL ENROLLMENT

Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB) or proof of tribal enrollment is required.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Please submit TWO letters of recommendation. We suggest a professor or advisor at school, and/or an adult friend at work or in your community who knows you well.
