Award Criteria

Merit – An applicant's merit will be determined by considering the student's academic progress as evidenced by grades and academic recognitions. For example, science fair competitions or debate team awards will be considered. Consideration will be awarded on a competitive basis with grade point average (GPA) serving as a substantial indicator of academic achievement. A GPA of at least 3.00 or better is highly recommended. Other factors also being considered will be, community service involvement and extracurricular activities.

Submittal Process

1. A scholarship request must be submitted through a Scholarship Application. A complete list of items required for the Scholarship Package submittal is shown on the next page of this document.
2. Applicant must show proof of acceptance into an accredited college or university.
3. Please Note: Any missing items not provided in the initial application submittal VOIDS the entire application. Please do it correctly the first time.

Winners will be determined by a weighted point system. The release of the award will be coordinated through the Educational Activities Committee. The deadline for the application submittal is April 21, 2023.

A Scholarship 'Theme Essay' Submittal is Required:

The essay should address the following: *How has Black history affected your choice of college or major?*

Items to be included in the Submittal Package:

1. Scholarship Application
2. Applicant must show proof of acceptance into an accredited college or university, prior to award of scholarship.
3. A sealed High School Transcript, graduating in the first half of the school year 2023.
4. Essay: Scholarship 'Theme Essay'
5. 2"x2" photo
