Chiawana Students' Frequently Asked Questions:

1. **Will my grade suffer over the closure if I'm not able to do the assigned work?**
 - a. NO, you will NOT be penalized for not being able to do classwork over the closure. Teachers may give students suggested activities to do over the closure time to keep their minds active.
 - b. For now, students taking College in the High and/or Advanced Placement courses may have an expectation of continued work and more information will be coming out.
2. **If the closure lasts longer, will we still be able to graduate?**
 - a. Seniors who were on track to graduate in June of 2020 will not be penalized.
3. **Do we have to check with our teacher everyday (because some of us are working longer hours)?**
 - a. Students need to check their school email DAILY.
4. **Will we have to make up all these cancelled days in the summer?**
 - a. Schools need to do our best to make up as much as possible before the June 19th date.
5. **When will I be able to take the Accuplacer (entrance exam for Running Start and College in the High School) test?**
 - a. We will arrange those exams with students when we return to school...more information to come.
6. **Will the rest of the school year be cancelled?**
 - a. This decision is dependent on our national, state, and local government officials/leaders.
7. **How will State Testing/Assessments affect me?**
 - a. All State Testing is cancelled for the remainder of this school year.
8. **If school is cancelled for longer, do we still get credits for our classes?**
 - a. More information to come, but students will not be penalized for these school cancelled days.
