Purpose of Scholarship:	To provide financial support in the area of higher education for students of Afro-American descent in their pursuit of academic success

**Award Basis**

**Merit** – An applicant's merit will be determined by considering the student's academic progress as evidenced by grades and academic recognitions. For example, science fair competitions or debate team awards will be considered.

Consideration will be awarded on a competitive basis with grade point average (GPA) serving as a substantial indicator of academic achievement. A GPA of at least 3.00 or better is highly recommended. Other factors also being considered will be, community service involvement and extracurricular activities.

**Financial Need** – Financial need will be factored in by taking into consideration the student's financial support from parents, friends and relatives. The applicant should also consider work plans while on campus and other possible sources of support.

1. Applicant will submit a written letter to the (EAC) requesting financial assistance. The financial need letter should include such topics as his college goals and a financial plan(s) as to how he might achieve those goals.
2. Financial need awards are not necessarily limited to books and supplies.

**Submittal Process**

1. A scholarship request must be submitted by way of a Scholarship Application. A complete list of items required for the Scholarship Package submittal is shown on the next page of this document.
2. Applicant must show proof of acceptance into an accredited college or university.

3. Please Note: Any missing items not provided in the initial application submittal VOIDS the entire application. Please do it correctly the first time.

Winners will be determined by a weighed point system. The release of the award will be coordinated through the Educational Activities Committee. Deadline for the application submittal is **July 1, 2020**.

A Scholarship ‘Theme Essay’ Submittal is Required:

The essay should address the following topic: *Why should young men of African-American descent finish high school and then go on to college?* Minimum: 300 words.

**Items to be included in the Submittal Package:**

1. Scholarship Application
2. Applicant must show proof of acceptance into an accredited college or university.
3. A sealed High School Transcript, graduating in the first half of the school year 2020\*\*
4. Essay:
  - a. Financial Need Essay (Optional), if applicant wants need to be considered in the submittal.
  - b. Scholarship ‘Theme Essay’
5. 2”x2” photo
