Baccalaureate is an optional graduation tradition that refers to a non-denominational ceremony held a few days before high school graduation that offers a quiet, intimate opportunity to pause and reflect on this rite of passage.

- * Arrive at Edgar Brown Stadium 1 hour before your graduating time
- * Bring your caps and gowns, medallions, honor cords, etc.
- * Do NOT bring valuables (purses, phones, etc.). There will be no place to store them.
- * Be on time

ATTENTION!!!! IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!!!

What to Wear and What NOT to Wear At Graduation

- ◇ All seniors will wear caps and gowns and a special medallion for the class of 2021.
- ◇ Students may also wear any cords given at CHS Senior Fest
- ◇ You may not wear leis until after the ceremony.
- ◇ Students are expected to dress appropriately for a formal ceremony
 - ◇ Males- slacks, dress shirt, dress shoes
 - ◇ Females- slacks, nice shirt/blouse, dress/skirt, appropriate dress shoes (must be able to walk comfortably)
- ◇ DO NOT decorate your cap or gown.

Students will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony if they are not dressed appropriately.

If you need help finding appropriate clothes for the ceremony, see Mr. Baker in the lower B Wing office for assistance.

Fines and Contracts

- All textbooks and supplies must be turned in
- The graduation contract must be turned in
- All fees and fines must be cleared (this includes fees for ID badges)

You will **ONLY** be allowed to choose a seat **AFTER** you are cleared for graduation.
****If you do not report, your seat for graduation will be ASSIGNED.**

Guest Seating: Get there early for best seats!

- This year planning to have three separate graduation ceremonies at Edgar Brown @ 4, 6, and 8
- Stairs **MUST** be clear during the ceremony for safety.
- Each graduating senior will be issued 5 tickets for family/friends
- A small number of seats will be available for limited mobility guests and wheel chairs along the top rail south of the press box. Due to limited space, only one escort per wheel chair.
- Seating available for hearing
