



Health Screening Guidelines for Pasco School District

UPDATED: August 25, 2020

Staff, students and visitors of the Pasco School District must complete a daily COVID-19 health screening and attestation before entering district facilities and are asked to stay home when sick. This protocol has been developed to align with state and local public health guidance and contains information to help individuals determine when they must stay home and when they may be on-site.

Please Note: Families utilizing Boys & Girls Clubs at district facilities will be asked to follow the Boys & Girls Club COVID-19 Wellness Screening Procedure.
