Social Distance Guidelines 3ft and 6ft

- Guidelines have changed in classrooms only, and only when seated. Students will need to be seated according to a seating chart kept by the teacher. These spaces can be 3ft apart.
- All other times students need to be kept at 6 feet apart. This applies to hallways, outside, the cafeteria, bathrooms and all other common areas.

Masks Are Still Required

All students are still required to wear masks on school campus at all times.

Mask breaks will occur once a day in designated areas at teachers scheduled time.

Students may remove masks to eat lunch in the cafeteria but then will be required to put them back on promptly after eating.



Still Sanitize Regularly and Often

- Students should sanitize their hands when they come in for the day and when returning to class from using the bathrooms.

We encourage:

- Families drive students to school, if possible.
- Unless an exemption is in place with the Pasco School District ALL students are required to wear a face mask!
- Report to grade level line and line up with social distancing when you arrive to school. Once you have passed your temperature check then you will go to grade level area or portable for your first period of the day to line up.
- Report to pick-up area and wait for parent/guardian with social distancing. (Front of Building)
- Parents are encouraged to drop students off beginning at 7:30 AM

WALKING TO SCHOOL & HOME GUIDELINES HAVE NOT CHANGED.

We encourage:

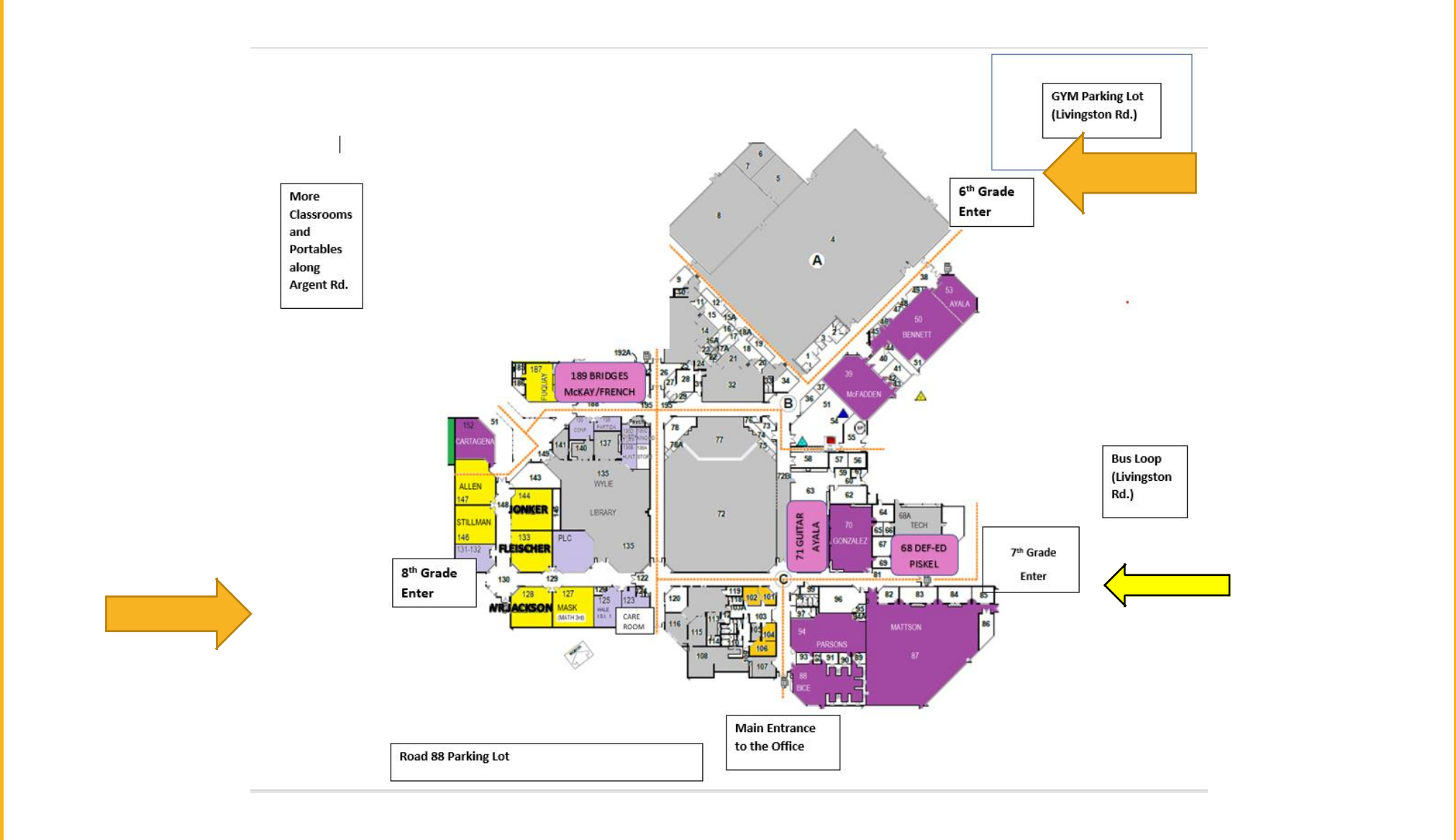
- Walking or biking where it is safe.
- Masks are required for all students while on campus.
- Report to grade level line and line up with social distancing when you arrive to school. Once you have passed your temperature check then you will go to grade level area or portable for your first period of the day.
- Leave for home when school gets out. Walk off campus with social distancing.
- Students are encouraged to not arrive prior to 7:30 AM
