For Kindergarten, Building Blocks for Science and the Smithsonian kits are being recommended for grades 1-5. The kits will roll out over the next few years. The attached PowerPoint shows the process the committee followed and the rationale for their decision. The rollout plan for the kits is included in the PowerPoint.</p> <p>The IMC unanimously agreed to take the recommendation to the school board.</p> <p>The recommendations will go to board for their consideration on May 9.</p> <p>LeAnn reviewed the progress of each curriculum review committee and where each is in the process.</p> <p>Social Studies: High School will be ready to present its recommendations on May 2. Middle and Elementary are in a holding pattern waiting for a few materials from vendors. The timelines have been pushed back for release on some of the materials from the publishers</p> <p>World Language- French: The group is ready to present and is scheduled on May 2.</p> <p>Novel Committee is continuing to narrow down titles for each grade.
