The Washington State University ProTeach Support Program, Tri-City Campus, is designed to serve Washington teachers who are seeking Professional Certification.

The College of Education at WSU Tri-Cities has designed a program to prepare teachers to meet the requirements of Professional Certification through the ProTeach portfolio.

The 2-semester program helps teachers examine their professional practice with the Professional Teaching Standards (WAC 180-78A-540). The cohort model emphasizes professional collaboration and reflective practice for the completion of the ProTeach Portfolio.

In the first half of the program, candidates will focus on:

- \*Fulfilling the required components of a classroom learning community.
- \*Designing a need-based Professional Growth Plan.

In the second half of the program, candidates will focus on:

- \* Requirements for curriculum, assessment, and instruction
- \*Completing the Professional Growth Plan with evidence of student impact.

Candidates are supported throughout the program to develop a clear understanding of the ProTeach standards, criterion, scoring rubrics, and required technology applications.

Instructors are trained scorers who will read and provide individual feedback on all documents.

WSUTC's support courses will help prepare teachers for portfolio submission, but the ProTeach Portfolio is externally scored and an individualized assessment, and therefore WSU cannot guarantee the success of any submission.

**Non-Credit ~ \$500 per course:** two consecutive courses /\$1000 total: Support I (fall) & II (spring)

This option is for teachers who *do not* want/need graduate credit. This preference includes the option to purchase 45 clock hours upon completion of each course. The fee for each support course is \$500.00 and is due by the end of the second week of WSU classes. Please be aware the support course fee of \$500 is in addition to the fee OSPI charges for the portfolio assessment.
