We have been experiencing many students bringing slime to school. Slime **should not** be brought to school. If slime is brought to school, the following steps will be taken.

1. **First offense** ----- (Minor) A warning will be given to the student.
2. **Second offense** ----- (Minor) The slime will be confiscated by the teacher.
3. **Third offense** ----- (Major) A discipline referral will be given to the student.
The slime will be confiscated.

The only time slime will be allowed at school, is when a student purchases a "Make Slime with Mr. Ehilis" pass. The student will be allowed to make the slime and then take the slime home. It should not return to school.



James McGee Elementary Notice Regarding Electronic Devices

We have been experiencing many students bringing electronic devices including cell phones, iPods, Nintendo DS games, MP3 players to school. If these items are brought to school, they should be kept in a safe/secure location such as a backpack. They **should not** be seen or heard during class time. They also **cannot** be used during recesses. These devices can be disruptive to the educational process. We cannot properly monitor content and appropriateness for school. If the device is a disruption, the following steps will be taken.

1. **First offense** ----- (Minor) A warning will be given to the student.
2. **Second offense** ----- (Minor) The device will be taken to the office.
The student may pick up the device at the end of the day.
3. **Third offense** ----- (Minor) The device will be taken to the office.
The parent must pick up the device.
4. **Fourth or additional offense** ----- (Major) A discipline referral will be given to the student.
The device will be taken to the office. The parent must pick up the device.

The school will not be held responsible for lost, broken or stolen devices.
